

## Suitable for:

It is suitable for anyone who needs to understand the principles of health and safety as part of their job, including team leaders and supervisors, HR professionals, facilities managers and those training young people in a working environment

## Duration:

3 days course + 1 day examination

## Entry equipment:

There are no specific barriers, in terms of academic qualifications, skills or experience to entry to the NEBOSH Award in Health and Safety at Work programme. The qualification includes a requirement to complete a risk assessment activity based in the candidate's own workplace. Candidates should discuss this with the accredited course provider before undertaking the qualification.

## Course content:

### HSW1 Workplace safety foundations

- Element 1: The foundations of health and safety.
- Element 2: The responsibility for health and safety.
- Element 3: Health and safety risk assessment and control.
- Element 4: Hazards and control associated with work equipment.
- Element 5: Transport safety.
- Element 6: Hazards and control associated with electricity.
- Element 7: Fire safety.
- Element 8: Hazards & control associated with manual handling & repetitive movement.
- Element 9: Hazards and control associated with hazardous substances.
- Element 10: Hazards and control associated with the working environment.

Unit HSW2 Workplace risk assessment

Unit HSW2 is the workplace-based risk assessment activity

How is it assessed?

**Unit HSW1** is a taught unit, assessed by a one hour multiple choice examination

Each examination consists of forty questions (1 mark each) with one correct and three incorrect responses available per questions

Each examination paper covers the whole unit syllabus with at least one question per unit element and all questions are compulsory

**Unit HSW2** is assessed by a one-hour practical assessment carried out in the candidates own workplace

This is held on a date set by the accredited course provider and must be taken within 14 days of a multiple choice examination

### **Course assessment and certification**

Once a candidate has achieved a Pass in both units they are normally considered to have completed the qualification and an overall qualification parchment will be issued, within 40 working days of the result declaration date for the second successfully completed unit.

**Course fee:** The course and examination fee is Rs. 16,000/- (Sixteen Thousand only) + 15% Service Tax (or as applicable)
