1. We have reviewed the unaudited financial results of Tata Projects Limited (the “Company”) for the quarter ended December 31, 2021 and the year to date results for the period April 01, 2021 to December 31, 2021, which are included in the accompanying ‘Statement of Unaudited Standalone Financial Results for the quarter and nine months period ended December 31, 2021’ (the “Statement”). The Statement has been prepared by the Company pursuant to Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the “Listing Regulations, 2015”), which has been digitally signed by us for identification purposes. The Statement is the responsibility of the Company’s management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
2. We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, “Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity” issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement.
3. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
4. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the Statement has not been prepared in all material respects in accordance with the applicable Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies and has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 52 of the Listing Regulations, 2015 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

We did not review the financial statements of one jointly controlled operation considered in the preparation of the statement and which constitute total assets of Rs. 11,886.96 lakhs and net assets of Rs. 1,010.97 lakhs as at December 31, 2021, total revenue of Rs. 9,331.77 lakhs, total comprehensive income (comprising of profit and other comprehensive income) of Rs. 1,599.46 lakhs and net cash inflows amounting to Rs. 1,061.42 lakhs for the period then ended. These financial statements and other financial information have been reviewed by other auditors whose report has been furnished to us, and our conclusion on the statement to the extent they have been derived from such financial statements is based solely on the report of such other auditors. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.
